The new fee of \$17,750 from the prior fee of \$2520 precludes all the small entities that I represent from ever being able to file for ReExamination. It is inconsistent to allow small entities (and micro entities) to file under reduced filing fees and then not allow reduced ReExam fees.

I am aware of a proposal for small entity fees and micro entity fees in the Fed. Reg. Vol 77, No. 173 dated Sept. 6, 2012 especially pg 55039. I would like to cast my vote in favor of these fees at least please with any further reduction of course also welcomed.
