USPTO Working Group

- USPTO will issue three Notices of Proposed Rulemaking this fall.
- The first NPRM, concerning TM regs, published on October 18, 2017 in the Federal Register 82 FR 48469, PDF copy located at:
 - <u>https://www.gpo.gov/fdsys/pkg/FR-2017-10-18/pdf/2017-22394.pdf</u>
- Two NPRMS one concerning Patent regs, the other concerning regs related to OPIA and OED, are currently being reviewed by DOC
- These Notices of Proposed Rulemaking will seek public comment on the removals, and USPTO will review those comments and then make decisions about removal through final rules.



USPTO Working Group

- These Notices of Proposed Rulemaking are an initial step in an ongoing process of reviewing USPTO's regulations to determine where regulatory reform can be accomplished.
- We will continue to follow these principles of regulatory reform in future rulemaking and in review of USPTO regulations.
- Public input continues to be valuable to us as we undertake this work.
