## **Nominee for Director of USPTO: Andrei lancu**

## 115th Congress, second session

#### **USPTO Director Nomination**

- Senate Confirmed Andrei Iancu as Director of the USPTO on Feb. 5, 2018, by a vote of 94-0
- Awaiting formal approval by the White House
- On Dec. 14, 2017, the Senate Judiciary Committee approved Mr. Iancu's nomination by unanimous consent
- Nomination hearing held on Nov. 29, 2017
- Chairman Grassley (R-IA) and Sen. Coons (D-DE) questioned Mr. Iancu at the hearing and members submitted 55 Questions for the Record (QFRs)

## **Congressional Activity – Calendar**

## 115th Congress, second session

- **Federal Budget FY2018:** Operating under a Continuing Resolution (CR) until February 8, 2018 for FY2018. A <u>new CR (#5) is pending in the Senate to extend funding through March 23; and will likely be amended. (to be updated at/before the meeting)</u>
- Legislative Agenda for beginning of 2018:
  - Budget / FY 2018 Appropriations
  - FY 2019 President's Budget
  - Immigration/Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)
  - Debt Ceiling (approx. March 2018)
  - Infrastructure

## **Judiciary Committee Retirements and Changes**

- Senate Judiciary Committee
  - Sens. Cory Booker (D-NJ) and Kamala Harris (D-CA) were added to the SJC
  - Sen. Orrin Hatch (R-UT) (President Pro Tempore) to retire
- House Judiciary Committee
  - **Rep. Jerry Nadler** (D-NY) became the Ranking Member of the Full Committee *(replacing Rep. John Conyers (D-MI))*
  - **Rep. Hank Johnson** (D-GA), became the Ranking Member in the Subcommittee *(replacing Rep. Jerry Nadler (D-NY))*
  - Chairman Robert Goodlatte (R-VA) to retire
  - Rep. Darrell Issa (R-CA), Chairman of the Subcommittee on the Courts, Intellectual Property and the Internet announced he was not running for reelection

## 115th Congress, second session

### **General Update**

- Consideration of IP issues likely to be dominated by Copyright measures.
- Patent measures may also be considered addressing PTAB reforms, sovereign immunity and other issues.

## **Telework Enhancement Act Pilot Program (TEAPP) Extension**

- USPTO's TEAPP authority expired on December 8, 2017
- H.R. 4171, a bill extending the program through December 31, 2020, was passed by the House on a voice vote on December 12, 2017
- Bill referred to the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee



#### **CR History:**

**1994** -- the last time all appropriations bills were passed individually prior to the start of the fiscal year

**1996** -- the last time the spending laws were passed on time (accomplished with an omnibus package of six spending bills)
