Legislative Activity 117th Congress

- IDEA Act (S. 632/H.R. 1728)
 - Inventor Diversity for Economic Advancement Act (IDEA) of 2021
 - Requires the USPTO to provide for the collection of voluntary demographic information of patent applicants
 - Introduced in the Senate and the House on March 9, 2021 (S. 632/H.R. 1728)
 - Similar versions introduced in the 115th and 116th Congress
 - Reported favorably out of the Senate Judiciary Committee on April 29, 2021 (15-7)



Legislative Activity 117th Congress

- Endless Frontier Act
 - Designate and support regional technology hubs in key areas that will spread innovation throughout the U.S.
 - Hearing held in the Senate Commerce Committee on April 14, 2021
 - Bill markup expected in May
- Drug pricing bills



Congressional Activity 117th Congress

- Nomination hearing for Mr. Don Graves to be Deputy Secretary of the U.S. Department of Commerce
 - Hearing before the Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee held on March 10, 2021
 - Reported favorably out of committee on April 28, 2021 (25-3)
- Nomination hearing for Ms. Leslie Kiernan to be General Counsel of the U.S. Department of Commerce
 - Hearing before the Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee held on April 21, 2021



Congressional Activity 117th Congress

- Senate Judiciary Subcommittee on Intellectual Property Hearing: Improving Access and Inclusivity in the Patent System: Unleashing America's Economic Engine (April 21, 2021)
- Letters from Senators
 - Patent Subject Matter Eligibility Study
 - Pilot program for sequenced examination of patent applications
 - Closing the gender gap in the patent bar
