- U.S. Supreme Court issued United States v. Arthrex, Inc., on June 21, 2021.



Cross-collaboration of training

- PTAB and Patents partner in several ways to provide judges and examiners with training opportunities.
 - PTAB provides training to Patents.
 - Quality Chat webinars
 - April 2021: How to strengthen Examiner Answers; >1,000 total examiner attendees
 - July 2021: Reversals of PTAB decisions by Federal Circuit
 - Detail assignments
 - 20 examiner detailees started in April 2021 for a term of 3 months
 - Hearing viewing
 - April 2021: Examiner viewing day for an ex parte appeal and AIA trial hearings
 - Patents provides training to PTAB.
 - Patent Training Academy: legal training for examiners is made available to PTAB
 - Technical training is made available to PTAB
