

Disposal Pendency (Goal: 13.5 months)





Staffing and process

- Examining attorney hiring
 - FY 2022: 93 examining attorneys hired
 - FY 2023: classes in October and April
 - TM Academy
- Post registration specialist hiring
 - More specialists being hired to assist with the backlog
- TM Flex conducting bad faith investigations
- TM Exam transition of examining attorneys to modernized IT system



Trademark Modernization Act flexible response periods

- Pre-registration responses to Office actions
 - Effective for Office actions issued on or after 12/3/22
 - Three months to respond
 - May request three month extension
 - Does not apply to Madrid Protocol Section 66(a) actions
- Post Registration responses
 - Effective for Office actions issued on or after 10/7/2023
