

Notice of Intention to Petition for Reinstatement

Jonathan G. Morton of Miami, Florida, whose registration number is 74,199, and who has been suspended pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 2(b)(2)(D) and 32, has filed, pursuant to 37 CFR § 11.60(h)(2), notice of his intention to petition for reinstatement. To become reinstated, a suspended practitioner must establish to the satisfaction of the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline that reinstatement would not be contrary to the public interest, and that the suspended practitioner has complied with the provisions of 37 CFR § 11.58 during the period of suspension. *See* 37 CFR § 11.60. Accordingly, information bearing upon the good moral character and reputation of Jonathan G. Morton is material to his eligibility for reinstatement. Any information tending to affect the eligibility of Jonathan G. Morton on moral, ethical or other grounds should be furnished to the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline in a written communication addressed to the Office of Enrollment and Discipline, Mail Stop OED, United States Patent and Trademark Office, P.O. Box 1450, Alexandria, VA 22313-1450, on or before April 20, 2024.
