Legislative activity 117th Congress

- IP related bills
 - The Patent Examination and Quality Improvement Act of 2022 (S. 4704)
 - The Interagency Patent Coordination and Improvement Act of 2022 (S. 4430)
 - The Patent Trial and Appeal Board Reform Act of 2022 (S. 4417)
 - The Inventor Diversity for Economic Advancement (IDEA) Act of 2021 (S. 632)
 - The Patents for Humanity Improvement Act (H.R. 5796/S. 4210)
 - The Patent Eligibility Restoration Act of 2022 (S. 4737)



Congressional activity 117th Congress

- Congressional hearings
 - Senate Judiciary Subcommittee on Intellectual Property: The Patent Trial and Appeal Board: Examining Proposals to Address Predictability, Certainty, and Fairness (June 22, 2022)
 - House Judiciary Subcommittee on Court, Intellectual Property, and the Internet:
 - The Patent Trial and Appeal Board After 10 Years: Impact on Innovation and Small Businesses (June 23, 2022)
 - The Patent Trial and Appeal Board After 10 Years, Part II: Implications of Adjudicating in an Agency Setting (July 21, 2022)
 - While the USPTO did not provide a witness, the Director submitted a letter to the House Judiciary Subcommittee outlining recent and ongoing initiatives at the PTAB.

Congressional activity 117th Congress (cont.)

Congressional inquiries

- Discretionary denial of institution of inter partes review proceedings and potential abuses of post-grant proceedings
- Drug pricing issues, including those relating to coordination between the USPTO and the FDA
- The accuracy of the data used in discussions around the role patents play in drug pricing
- Continuations practice
- Whether a patent small claims court should be established
- Whether the U.S. should establish a unified intellectual property office
- The role and effect of non-fungible tokens on the U.S. intellectual property system

Preview for the 118th Congress

- Potential legislative issues:
 - Continued debate on Section 101 reform
 - Continued debate on PTAB reform
 - Continued debate on drug pricing
- Potential subcommittee changes
 - Retirement of Sen. Leahy, Chair of Senate IP Subcommittee
