It has been brought to my attention that there is a proposal to levy a fee of \$100 or more for submitting evidence in a letter of protest for newly filed trademarks. While I understand there is a cost to reviewing these letters of protest, the cost should be the burden of the person/company filing the request for the trademark. There are way too many trademarks which appear to be frivolous in nature, such as the recent approval for the word Dogs (reg # 5843989). This simple word is used on literally thousands of products. As a small business owner, these frivilous trademarks impede my ability to create product and earn a living. Trademarks should be granted to protect brands, not to grant the ability of the trademark holder to issue takedown notices en masse - granting them sole access to a given market.

I strongly urge you to reconsider creating a fee for submittal of letters of protest as this is the only avenue some have to protect themselves and the marketplace they serve.
