I am writing to express the support of United Launch Alliance for establishing a US Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) in Colorado. Colorado is home to a number of technology industries positioned for increased outreach activities – better connecting patent filers and innovators with the USPTO.

Colorado has a number of growing highly technical industries, to include: Aerospace; energy; biosciences; and telecommunications. Each one of these industries is responsible for sustaining and growing jobs throughout the United States. These industries also make up a majority of patents filed each year with the USPTO. Furthermore, positioning a USPTO office in Colorado will bring significant economic benefit to the entire state.
