I understand that micro-entity fees now reside within the Director's section 10 authority. The AIA granted that authority to the Director for the first time last month. Delay in exercising the authority may begin to erode it. Why not use the fee setting authority promptly?

Thus I encourage the Patent Office to move with alacrity and institute the micro entity fees before December 2011.
