Only use subclasses: when not only a constructional detail is of importance but also the general arrangement of the reel, in addition a class in B65H 75/38 or B65H 75/40 and subgroups is given. Multiple constructional details may be classified.	If a constructional detail which is not covered by subgroups B65H75/4402 – B65H75/486 is of relevance, symbol B65H75/44 can be used provided that the document is also classified in one of the subgroups B65H75/38 - B65H75/425. Multiple constructional details may be classified.
